

# Bullrush Reg'd Bulldogs - Health Contract and Guarantee

The Seller, Amy Presse and the Buyer(s) (**client**), hereby agree as follows:

The Seller hereby sells to the Buyer for the amount of **\$(total)**, In accordance with the terms of this contract: a (**color**) (**sex**) (**breed**) puppy, identified with the micro-chip # (**chip**) from the litter whelped on (**date**) out of (**sire - CKC registration#**) and (**dam - CKC registration#**).

## Buyer's Responsibilities:

- \* Buyer is responsible for all shipping costs UNLESS stated otherwise. Pup must be paid in FULL before it leaves us.
- \* Buyer will have the pup examined by a licensed veterinarian within 72 hours of delivery. Seller must be informed immediately of the examination result by email or by fax. The failure of this will result in the cancellation of this guarantee.
- \* The Buyer shall maintain the puppy in good condition, including adherence to a regular immunization schedule, heartworm preventative, good diet, and a clean and safe environment.
- \* Buyer will be responsible for ALL medical expenses incurred. Buyer is aware that owning a puppy means trips to the veterinarian and understands that he/she will be responsible for all payments.
- \* If at any time in its life, the puppy is to be sold or given away, the Buyer shall notify the Seller and give the Seller first option to buy the puppy back at a price not to exceed the original purchase price.

## Seller's Responsibilities:

- \* Seller will have the puppy checked (and found to be in good health) by a licensed veterinarian within 72 hours PRIOR to being delivered. As of the date of delivery, the puppy will have received age appropriate vaccinations and de-wormings. The Seller will inform the Buyer of these and of future vaccinations and de-wormings due.

## Health Guarantee:

- \* The puppy is guaranteed until one year of age against fatal and life-altering congenital and genetic diseases that adversely affect the health of the animal. Such ailments include Severe Hip Dysplasia (which hampers the dogs movement and natural gait, and requires surgery to correct), and kidney, heart, pancreas, spine, and liver problems of a severe and life-threatening or life-altering nature.
- \* This guarantee does not cover what in the Breed is considered typical: cherry eye, entropion, ectropion loose hips or knees, skin allergies, Demodetic mange, autoimmune disorders, elongated soft palate, trachea issues, stenotic nares, inverted tails, fertility issues, parasitic, fungal or bacterial infection, or respiratory infection.
- \* This guarantee does not include Coccidia and Kennel Cough, which is common in puppies that are shipped and usually caused by bacteria. Kennel Cough is self-limiting and like the common cold, it must run its course. Full recovery is expected and Kennel Cough on its own is not life threatening.
- \* Any physical problem which is or could be caused by accident or injury, neglect or poor diet is not covered in this guarantee.
- \* If the puppy dies during the time frame of this guarantee, purchaser agrees to have a necropsy performed to ascertain the cause of death. If the cause of death is determined by a veterinarian to be genetic or congenital, seller will replace the puppy. Shipping costs are the responsibility of the buyer.
- \* This guarantee does not cover death if your pup has been put under anesthesia for surgery and dies.
- \* There is no guarantee or warranty that the Buyer will be able to show or breed the puppy regardless of show, breeding potentials or lineage.
- \* Seller will not be responsible for any medical expenses incurred.
- \* All items covered under this guarantee are by replacement only. We do not give refunds.

**In the case that the puppy shows serious genetic or congenital defect, they will be replaced as follows:**

\* Puppy must show the defect by six months of age. Seller must be notified of the problem within 2 business days of the licensed veterinarian determination and have two reports from two unassociated veterinarians stating the same problem and Seller will provide a replacement puppy of equivalent value.

\* In the case of severe Elbow or Hip Dysplasia, the radiograph should be permanently identified in the film emulsion with registered name and/or number, name of the veterinarian or hospital making the film, and the date of the radiograph. Furthermore, the radiograph and report must meet OFA's (Orthopedic Foundation for Animals) standard submission requirements.

\* A returned puppy must be returned to the Breeder in good condition, other than the specified problem, at the expense of the Buyer. The owner will then qualify for a replacement puppy.

\* Buyer is responsible for transportation costs to and from the Seller on a replacement puppy.

\* This guarantee applies to the original puppy only and is nontransferable to a second party.

\* No replacement puppy will be given if the puppy has been bred, spayed, neutered, or euthanized without permission of the Seller.

\* No replacement will be given if pup dies and Buyer does not perform necropsy or if necropsy does not show death was caused by congenital defect. Seller has the right to request pup's remains for an independent necropsy examination.

\* Replacement puppy will be mutually agreed upon by both parties and will be of comparable quality. It is understood that the replacement puppy may not be from the exact same parents as the original puppy.

\* No refund, in part or in full, will be given.

\* In the event of any litigation in connection with this guarantee, purchaser shall be responsible for legal fees incurred by Seller. This contract is valid only for original purchaser and puppy, and is not transferable.

\* Registration papers for all limited registered puppies and adult dogs sold as "pet" only will be held by the Seller and only released to the Buyer once proof of spay/neuter has been provided. Proof of altering must come in the form of a spay/neuter certificate signed by the licensed veterinarian who performed the surgery. THE PUPPY OR DOG'S MICROCHIP NUMBER MUST BE INDICATED ON THE VETERINARIANS SPAY/NEUTER CERTIFICATE.

\* Registration papers will be sent by certified mail. If the papers are lost, the Buyer is responsible for obtaining new papers. We will assist by providing copies, if available.

\* This contract supersedes any and all previous agreements. This contract is null and void if the terms and conditions are not fulfilled.
